6 Different herbaceous plants in one 6-pack for sale.

The Conservation District is joining forces this year with Penn State Extension Master Gardeners to offer packs of six different herbaceous plants, along with our tree and shrub seedlings. This selection of perennials is great to attract pollinators to your garden, farm, and landscape. Pollinators are necessary for our food crops to grow. With the decline of these important insects, so will our food supply. The plants can be intermixed in your vegetable garden, flower garden, meadow or shrub borders.



Monarda bradburiana – Bee Balm grows to about three feet, in most any soil. It will bloom in the summer.

Oenothera fruticosa – Sundrops is an early summer bloomer. It reaches about 2 feet in height.



Penstemon digitalis – Beardtongue blooms in looks great throughout



the spring-time in most soils. After blooming, the foliage the season.



Baptisia australis – False indigo is in the pea family. This plant easily reaches four feet and blooms in the spring. A great plant spring through fall.



Aster ericoides 'Snow flurry' – White aster is a low growing aster that blooms in the fall.

Solidag caesia - Blue-stemmed goldenrod is one of the best pollinator plants in this group. Blooming in the fall, it is not aggressive like the Canada goldenrod and adds beautiful fall color.



All perennials in this selection are full sun plants, native, and great pollinator plants. Careful selection of these plants has allowed for color from spring through fall in your garden.
