

DECLARATION OF DISASTER EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, on or about September 1, 2021, a Severe Storm has caused or threatens to cause injury, damage, and suffering to the persons and property of GERMANY TOWNSHIP, and.

WHEREAS, the Severe Storm has endangered the health, safety, and welfare of a substantial number of persons residing in GERMANY TOWNSHIP, and threatens to create problems greater in scope than GERMANY TOWNSHIP may be able to resolve; and

WHEREAS emergency management measures are required to reduce the severity of this disaster and to protect the health, safety, and welfare of affected residents in GERMANY TOWNSHIP:


NOW, THEREFORE, we, the undersigned Supervisors of GERMANY TOWNSHIP, pursuant to the provisions of Section 7501 of the Pennsylvania Emergency Management Services Code, (35 PA C.S., Section 7501), as amended, do hereby proclaim the existence of a disaster emergency in GERMANY TOWNSHIP


FURTHER, we direct the GERMANY TOWNSHIP Emergency Management Coordinator to coordinate the activities of the emergency response, to take all appropriate action needed to alleviate the effects of this disaster, to aid in the restoration of essential public services, and to take any other emergency response action deemed necessary to respond to this emergency.


STILL FURTHER, we authorize officials of GERMANY TOWNSHIP to act as necessary to meet the current demands of this emergency, namely: by the employment of temporary workers, by the rental of equipment, by the purchase of supplies and materials, and by entering into such contracts and agreements for the performance of public work as may be required to meet the emergency, all without regard to those time-consuming procedures and formalities normally prescribed by law, mandatory constitutional requirements excepted.


This Proclamation shall take effect immediately.
