### **Township Municipal Park Recreation Plan**

Mr. Thaeler, Ms. Marshall and Ms. Koch went over the proposed recreation plan, there is still work to be done. Mr. Thaeler hopes to be back in March with the completed plan.

Mr. Schreibman came to the workshop to review the park plan and look at the proposed area where the park will be built. However, it was raining and he could not get to the back portion of the lot where the park will be built. He did discuss with the Supervisors some points on how to fill out the application for a grant to build Phase I of the park.

### **Roadmaster Report:**

1. Trying to keep the roads plowed and salted.

3. Mr. Waltz would like to have the Supervisors look into the agreement with the Littlestown Borough for the maintenance of their portion of Kindig Road. Supervisors will have Attorney James review and see if we can give that portion back to the Borough.

### **Secretary's Report:**

1. Reminded Supervisors of bid opening in Hanover, Chairman Osborne will be attending the bid opening tonight.
2. Supervisor Ketterman, Ms. Hansen and Tim Waltz will be attending the PSAT's conference in April. When Mr. Dell gets back from Florida if he wants he can attend also per the Supervisors.

3. The Gettysburg Road Improvement Project bid opening has been rescheduled for February 18<sup>th</sup> at 9:30 a.m.
4. The Supervisors signed the Declaration of Disaster Emergency for Winter Storm Jonas. If the County reaches its threshold and the state declares it a disaster funding may be available.
5. The complaint at 454 Mengus Mill Road, the 60 days are up, this will be on the agenda for Monday night's regular meeting when it can be discussed with Attorney James.
6. The Williams Field road maintenance bond will be up on February 11, 2016. The roads have been inspected, this will be on the agenda for the regular February Supervisors' meeting.
