Planning Commission Report:

Mr. Thaeler, Adams County Principal Planner came to the June meeting to discuss and answer any questions the Commission may have on the proposed Township Recreation Plan.

The Commission is recommending approval.

Roadmaster Report:

1. CE Williams will be in Town on or around June 15th to start the overlay work on Locust Drive.
2. Shiloh Paving will be starting the road repairs on Drew Lane around June 21st /22nd.
3. Hammaker will be coming to do seal coat work on Teeter, Kingsdale, Mengus Mill and Mathias sometime in the next week or two.
4. Had to replace the battery in the Kubota Tractor.

Project Coordinator:

1. Gettysburg Road Improvements has started, Tim and Mike will need to flag when the contractor closes Fish and Game Road next week.
2. Ulricktown Culvert replacement, waiting on DEP permits.
3. Kingsdale Road Phase I will be getting documents ready to bid.
4. Mengus Mill Bridge, the state has selected the consulting firm, they will be meeting with the Township sometime in July.
5. Bittle Road Culvert Project, because the property is in Agricultural Preservation there are numerous agencies involved. The property in question will need to be condemned, appraised and signed off by the property owner. More on what's involved will be forthcoming. The Supervisors asked about just closing the road and giving it back to the homeowner. Mr. Dell doesn't believe that should be an option. It is a through road and

should be left in the Township in case of accidents, emergencies, etc. The Supervisors asked Ms. Hansen to look into what it takes to close a road.
