### **Planning Commission Report**

Marvin E and Barbara Anne Brown Minor Subdivision, the Planning Commission has recommended the Supervisors approve the minor subdivision plan. This will be on the regular meeting agenda on February 10, 2020 for approval.

### **Roadmaster Report:**

Mr. Waltz updated the Supervisors on the following items;

1. Roberts Road Bridge, Mr. Waltz and Supervisor Albin met with Mt. Joy about repairing the Roberts Road Bridge. The Supervisors will set up a meeting with Mt. Joy in April when Mr. Dell returns from Florida.
2. Mr. Waltz is working with a septic company that spilled some oil on Matthew Court.
3. Clear View Excavation will begin pipe replacement on Teeter and Harney Roads soon.
4. There was an accident at Gettysburg Road and Fish and Game taking out our street signs. Ms. Hansen has received the accident report and is filing a claim with the insured's insurance company.
5. 523 St. Johns Road, the property has still not been cleaned up or taped off where the house is falling in. The Supervisors will have Attorney James begin legal proceedings.
6. 79 Darlyn Drive has constructed two (2) pillars at the end of their driveway in the Township's right of way. The structures with lights are at the edge of the road and the snowplow cannot plow in front of their home. These structures need to be moved back off the road.
7. Mr. Waltz met with Mr. Kegarise and Mr. Bechtel about the shed and vehicles located on Mr. Kegarise's property but belong to Mr. Bechtel. Mr. Bechtel will be removing the shed and all other property that is his but is on Mr. Kegarise's property.

### **Secretary's Report:**

Ms. Hansen reviewed the following items with the Supervisors:

1. The joint bid opening with the Hanover Borough is tonight, Chairman Osborne will be attending the opening.
2. The Auditors have completed the 2019 Audit.

3. Gettysburg Road Phase III is just about ready to go out for bid. Supervisors will approve at the regular meeting on February 10, 2020.
4. Mr. Waltz also brought up the need to put the Bittle Road Phase IV, Dirt and Gravel Grant out for bid soon too. Supervisors will put this on the February 10<sup>th</sup> agenda.
5. Pipers Choice 18-month Public Security for the Stormwater Pond is up. C. S. Davidson and Gettysburg Engineering went out and checked the pond. Both are recommending the Township release the security.

1. Chairman Osborne will be meeting with Mr. Dell, Mr. Vranich, WM Hill Associates about the progress of the park project when Mr. Dell returns from Florida. Chairman Osborne is looking for members for the recreation committee.
