2. Roberts Road Bridge, the Township received a high priority notification letter from Mr. Cameron, with Pennoni. The letter requires a preparation of a Plan of Action within seven (7) days. Mr. Vranich has been preparing drawings to remove the structure and replace with a culvert. Mr. Cameron approved the scheduled corrective action of replacing the bridge with a three-sided box culvert in 2021.
