The Germany Township Supervisors met for a workshop at 9:30 a.m. at the township office, 136 Ulricktown Road. The meeting was called to order by Tom Osborne, Chairman; Supervisor Jack Ketterman and Supervisor Elwood Albin were also present. Also, in attendance, Secretary/Treasurer, Susan Hansen, Carroll Dell, Project Coordinator/Planning Chairman and Tim Waltz, Roadmaster.

Comments:

Mr. McKean talked to the Board about the proposed Mayberry at Mason Dixon Subdivision Development. This proposed development of 500 single family residential units marketed towards “active adults” will be located in Germany Township (98 units), Littlestown Borough and Union Township. The discussion was about a traffic impact study being done by PennDOT and Transportation Resource Group (TRG). Union Township is proposing a request for proposals to do their own traffic study. The Board has decided to wait and review the PennDOT study before they propose any type of traffic study.

Planning Commission Report/Project Coordinator:

There was not a planning meeting in February.

Mr. Dell discussed the Roberts Road Bridge joint project with Mt. Joy with the Supervisors. This is a joint project to replace the culvert on the Roberts Road Bridge. Mt. Joy will take the lead on the project and Erik Vranich will represent the Township along with Mr. Dell.

1. Mr. Waltz took the virtual Dirt and Gravel training course.
2. There was an accident on the Feeser Road Bridge. Mr. Waltz has a meeting set up with Mr. Cameron, bridge inspector with Pennoni Associates. Ms. Hansen will get the police report and start a claim with the insured’s insurance company.
3. We new batteries for the radios, cost will be \$117.00 each. Ms. Hansen will order.
4. Mr. Waltz will be on vacation February 12th – February 22nd.
