1. Mr. Waltz discussed with the Board the Updyke Road closure. Mr. Cameron with Pennoni Engineering will be inspecting the bridge for damage. Clear View Excavating will be sending a proposal for reconstructing the damage to the road.
2. Mr. Waltz stated the construction equipment for the Gettysburg Road Phase IIIB is being left parked on the edge of the road and is causing a hazard. Ms. Hansen will let Mr. Vranich the engineer know so he can let GB Groft the contractor move the equipment.
3. The headwall removed from the Crosswinds site is the Township's and Mr. Waltz will pick it up this week.

2. Mayberry at Mason Dixon – The new date for the meeting is September 16th.
